Heather's Recipe: Strawberry Santa Hats!

Easy to make and your little elves can help too! Wishing you all a warm & wonderful holiday season!

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 lb. strawberries with the tops cut off
- 8 oz. softened cream cheese
- 3-4 TBSP powdered sugar (depending on how sweet you like it)
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- Vanilla wafers (OREOS are good too if chocolate is your thing!)

INSTRUCTIONS:

STEP 1: Wash and dry your strawberries.

STEP 2: Mix the cream cheese, vanilla, and sugar together.

STEP 3: Pipe the cream cheese mixture around the outside edge of the wafer then add a drop of the mixture in the center of the cookie (this helps keep the strawberry on the cookie).

STEP 4: Press the strawberry on top of the mixture to create the white trim on your Santa hat.

STEP 5: Add a drop of the cream cheese mixture to the tip of the strawberry to create the pom-pom on Santa's hat!

Apply for SNAP by phone!

Our Neighbors' Table is a SNAP Outreach Partner. We can help you apply for SNAP (food stamps) by phone. Call Tress at 978-388-1907, ext. 18 to apply, help with an open SNAP case, or to answer your questions about SNAP.



SNAP benefits are put on an electronic card that is used like an ATM card or a bank card and can be used at most supermarkets, convenience stores, and some farmers' markets. Income guidelines apply.

Community Resources: Massachusetts Chapter 115 Veterans' Benefits

The Chapter 115 Benefits Program is run by the Massachusetts Department Veterans' Services (DVS). DVS runs the program in partnership with local Veterans' Service Officers (VSOs). The Program provides financial aid for food, shelter/housing, clothing, and medical care to veterans and their dependents who have limited incomes.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Residency in Massachusetts—1 day
- Honorable Discharge, 180 days of Active Duty Service
- Dependent, spouse, or un-remarried spouse

INCOME GUIDELINES—MAXIMUM MONTHLY*:

- Single—\$2,126
- 2 Person—\$2,873

*may still qualify if over income

ASSET LIMITS:

- Single—\$5,000
- Married—\$9,800

Volunteer Profile: Rita Comtois



In 2016, when Rita retired from her job as a psychologist, she knew she wanted to volunteer somewhere to keep busy. An Amesbury resident, she had heard of ONT. She thought she might help out at the Wednesday meal, but when she went to the volunteer orientation, she learned that she was needed to help in the Amesbury Market which was newly built at the time. Rita had no idea then that she would help out in almost every volunteer

position ONT has.

Before the COVID emergency, Rita mostly helped out at check-out and restocking the market, usually 4 days a week. These days you'll find her greeting guests when they arrive and helping to put their groceries in their vehicle twice a week. Rita tells us she enjoys doing this work. She says, "I like the camaraderie of the volunteers. I've gotten to know a lot of the guests. I like the mission. I like what we do and seeing the people we serve."

It is thanks to dedicated volunteers like Rita that ONT is able to serve our guests. Rita says many times guests have thanked her for volunteering and helping to bring them their food. Her response is that the guests are doing as much for her as she is for them. Helping people at ONT has made her feel like she's involved in something important, saying, "It feels like a community."
